The following terms apply to the practical training:

1. General

The bachelor's curriculum in social work (23.11.2015) provides detailed information on the following terms, especially the content, objectives and forms of practical training.

2. Objectives

The project exists so that students can acquire real-life skills, become familiar with the reality of professional social work, and better understand the relationship between theory and practice.

3. Obligations of participants

By signing this contract, the student, the practice site and the university promise to fulfil the following obligations:

The student must coordinate with the practice site and the university instructor directing the project with regard to the specific requirements of the practical training. In particular, the student must

- implement the tasks and goals identified in the training agreement;
- work through the tasks identified by the accompany seminar and with the practice site;
- apply and test knowledge by performing practical tasks under professional guidance;
- adhere to the practice site rules (in particular its regulations regarding work, accident prevention, and confidentiality); and
- think actively about his or her own work and practical experience during the accompanying supervisory sessions.

The practice site shall select a staff member responsible for professionally supervising the student during the practical training. In particular, the supervisor shall:

- develop a training plan and practice site activities and support the student in completing them;
- ensure the students have access to relevant information and data for activities at the practice site;
- carry out weekly supervisory sessions with the student;
- work together with instructors;
- issue a certificate indicating that the student has completed a minimum of 85 days of practical training; and
- assess the student's performance during the practical training.

The university must offer a seminar to accompany the project and provide supervision. Among other things, the instructor directing the project shall:

- approve the practice site by signing the practical training agreement and the training plan;
- make suggestions and help the student develop his or her own project focus.
- work together with the practice site.

4. Working hours – vacation – illness

The working hours during the practical training shall correspond to those of full-time employees at the practice site. The student is not eligible for vacation days. Any days that the student misses must be made up later in coordination with the university and the practice site. In case of illness, the student must immediately inform the practice site.

5. Compensation

The practical training phase of the second-year project is an obligatory curricular practicum. Accordingly, §22 (1) 1 MiLoG (German law regulating the minimum wage) does not apply and the student is not entitled to compensation. The university nevertheless sees some form of appropriate compensation as desirable.
